Alder & Rustic Alder



Alder is a soft hardwood with fine, straight grain and even texture. The color is uniform and ranges from light tan to honey colored, with no difference between heartwood and sapwood. Small clusters of minor knots are characteristic. Alder takes stains well and finishes beautifully.


Cherry & Rustic Cherry

Cherry's classic, smooth grain finish, deep rich-red color, and stability make it an elegant choice for fine cabinetry. Strong, stiff and moderately hard, Cherry is exceptionally stable and unsurpassed in its finishing qualities. An occasional bird peck or gum spot will be found in some pieces, which enhances Cherry's distinct character. Unique in its photosensitivity, Cherry's reddish color deepens with age to warm, dark brown hue.

Hickory




Hickory is a beautiful open grained wood. It is one of the most durable domestic hardwoods available. Hickory can exhibit extreme color variations and particularly appeals to people who love nature and a true wood look. Hickory can include bird pecks, burls, and mineral streaks. These indigenous qualities are not considered defects but actually appeal to the naturalist.



Lyptus

Lyptus is a beautiful hardwood that has received overwhelming praise among professionals for its workability, machining properties, density, finish ability, overall strength, sustainability and exotic appeal. It is an ideal hardwood for cabinetry, millwork, furniture and flooring. The grain is straight, even and coarse-textured, with a slight pinkish hue. Lyptus trees are grown on plantations certified by Cerflor, Brazil's national sustainable forestry certification, making it an excellent option for eco-minded customers. Lyptus wood offers excellent quality, remarkable beauty, and sustainability.

Maple




The value of hard **Maple** is its strength, wear resistance, and beauty. Maple is a wood that is evenly textured with a natural luster. While the grain is usually straight, it can also appear wavy or curly. Decorative growth patterns can be found in Maple such as bird's-eye, maple burl, leaf and fiddleback. These characteristics of maple add to its highly prized beauty and luster.



Oak

The value of **Red Oak** lies in its strength, beauty and adaptability, making it ideal for cabinetry. It is hard and highly shock-resistant with excellent matching characteristics and uniform coloration. Red Oak is a dense, open, hard-grained wood with varying vertical and arch patterns. Dark mineral streaks are common and enhance the attractive texture of Red Oak wood.






Pine




Knotty Pine's evenly grained softwood ranges in color from vanilla to brown with a reddish hue. Distinctive knots, ranging in size, shape and color, are a familiar feature of Pine wood. These striking patterns give Knotty Pine a charming appearance. The density of Pine wood varies from hard around the knots to soft in other areas. This variation in density can cause variation in finish absorption. Light distressing is included as standard on all Knotty Pine orders.



Walnut


Our **Walnut** features both lighter sapwood and deeper heartwood. Colors offer a high contrast, ranging from creamy brown to a beautiful dark chocolate brown with rich purplish undertones. Black Walnut is normally straight-grained and is noted for its beautiful grain character, producing more figure variation than any other wood.

Custom Ceruse Oak

Ceruse Oak dates back to the 1500s. Ceruse is a white additive that was originally used in cosmetics until artisans discovered that it was beautiful as an accent color on porous woods. When applied to a wood such as Oak, the white pigment fills and highlights grain without changing the overall color of the wood's finish.

Bellevue Cabinetry offers this old-world technique with a custom twist by providing limitless Ceruse options. Add the white Ceruse technique to any stain, paint or paint match color. Bellevue also provides the textured technique in multiple oak spe-cie. You can choose between red or white oak and quarter sawn red Oak or white Oak.

We take it one step further and allow our customers to achieve just the right sheen level. We offer No Sheen, Flat, Matte, Satin and High Gloss.



The flat side of this panel faces forward, with the raise rising forward to-ward the back of the door. This maintains girth, reduc-es rattle and provides color consistency by allowing us to always use solid wood with our stained offering





Raised Panel doors have a solid center panel that rises from the door frame. These panels are available with several profile options and offer many decorative possibilities.


TRIPLE X

EURO CONSTRUCTION



- A Wall Top 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood: Exposed front edges are edge-banded to match finish
- B Wall & Base Shelves 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood: Edgebanded front edge or upgrade to 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood bullnose on front edge. Shelves are adjustable in 1 1/4" increments
- Wall & Base Back 3/4" plywood hanging rail system with 1/4" natural plywood wood veneer interior
- Wall & Base End Panel CONCEALED: 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood EXPOSED: Ends will have a matching species wood veneer finished to match the door
- Wall Bottom 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood: Exposed front edges are edge-banded to match finish Bottoms are finished to match exterior
- Base Floor 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood: Exposed front edges are edgebanded to match finish
- G Base Drawer Box 5/8" thick solid hardwood sides dovetailed corners with 1/4" natural birch captured bottom. Upgrade to 3/4" solid hardwood dovetailed corners with 1/2" natural birch captured bottom. Drawer glides are full extension, soft close, undermount
- (H) Base Top Stretchers 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood
- Toe Board 1/4" thick recessed toe kick, 1/4" thick material finished to match the exterior is included

TRADITIONAL CONSTRUCTION



- (A) Wall Top 1/2" natural birch plywood veneer interior.
- Wall & Base Shelves 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood: Edgebanded front edge or upgrade to 3/4" Natural Birch Plywood bullnose on front edge.
- Wall & Base Back 1/2" plywood hanging rail system with 1/4" natural plywood wood veneer interior
- Wall & Base End Panel CONCEALED END PANEL 1/2" natural birch plywood recessed into the solid wood front frame. EXPOSED END PANEL applied 1/4" furniture grade wood veneer panel that is stained, sealed and top coated, creating a near-flush 3/4" thick side. Upgrade your exposed end to 3/4" thick plywood with locking mitre joint matching species wood veneer finish to match door.
- (E) Wall Bottom 1/2" thick natural birch plywood.
- Base Floor 1/2" thick natural birch plywood.
- **G** Base Drawer Box 5/8" thick solid hardwood sides dovetailed corners with 1/4" natural birch captured bottom. Upgrade to 3/4" solid hardwood dovetailed corners with 1/2" natural birch captured bottom. Drawer glides are full extension, soft close, undermount
- Base Top Stretchers 1/2" Natural Birch Plywood or upgrade to 1/2" full dust cover.
- Toe Board 1/2" thick recessed plywood toe kick. 1/4" thick plywood toe board, finished to match the exterior, is included. 4" high by 3" deep finished toe space.
- Wall & Base Face Frame 1 1/2" x 3/4" solid hardwood components.
